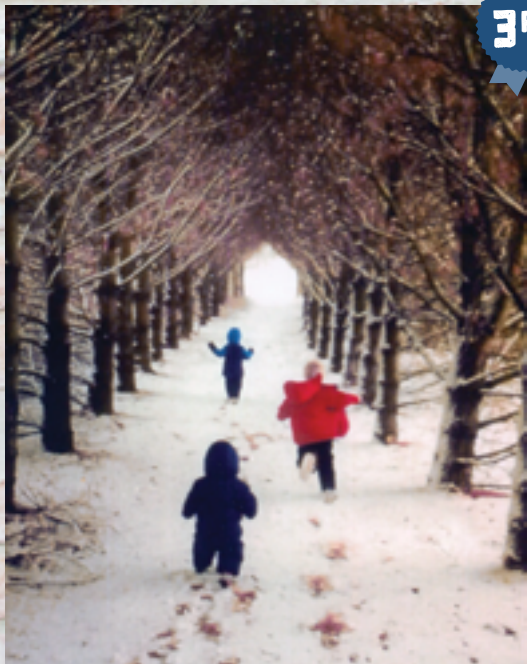

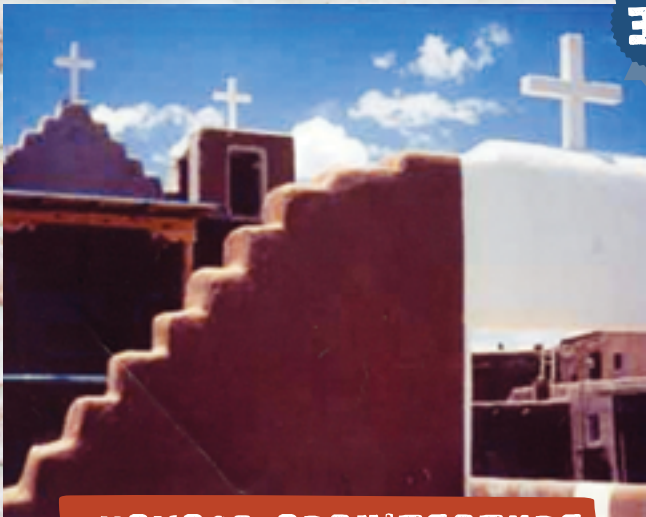

2018 PHOTO CONTEST RULES

CATEGORIES: Community • Nature • People • Pets

RULES:

1. You must have an NMB life insurance policy or annuity contract by the contest deadline.
2. The subject of your photo must be one of the four categories listed above.
3. Submit an 8" x 10" (preferred) or 5" x 7" color or black and white print by mail.
4. Attach a label to the back of your photo and print your name, address, email address, phone number, policy number, photo category, and photo title.
5. You must have photographed your entry in the past year. Only one entry per member will be accepted.
6. Photos must be mailed flat. Wrap in cardboard to avoid postal damage.
7. Framed or matted photos, and photos that have previously won an NMB prize, will not be accepted. No professional photos accepted.
8. Entries may not be altered using image editing software.
9. All entries become the property of National Mutual Benefit for its use and will not be returned.
10. If there are less than five submissions in a category, prizes may not be awarded.
11. Entries must be postmarked on or before July 20, 2018.
